IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES

PAP Thesis/Dissertation Grant

The PAP Thesis/Dissertation Grant is part of the Development Program of the PAP which aims to support the conduct of research by providing financial assistance to members who are completing their Master's thesis or Doctoral dissertation.

Eligibility

The Grant shall be open to PAP members who meet the following requirements:

- 1. a PAP member in good standing;
- 2. a registered psychometrician for Thesis and/or a registered psychologist already, for a Dissertation;
- 3. must be enrolled in a university of good standing;
- 4. must have completed all necessary requirements or prerequisites prior to enrolling for thesis and dissertation units (e.g., all coursework, and if relevant, comprehensive examination);
- 5. must have an approved thesis/dissertation proposal and final paper; and
- 6. must have a general weighted average of at least 1.50 or equivalent in the required courses leading to Master's or Doctoral degree applied for.

Procedure

- 1. All applications shall be received by the PAP Secretariat.
- 2. Applicants shall submit two (2) certified true copies of the following documents:
 - a) Accomplished application form
 - b) The approved Thesis or Dissertation Defense Panel Report
 - c) Letter of recommendation from thesis/dissertation adviser
 - d) Photocopy of the enrollment/registration form
- 3. The Awards Committee shall review the thesis/dissertation grant applications.
- 4. The grantee shall receive an amount of Php 30,000 (thesis) and Php 40,000 (dissertation).

Entitlement and Obligations

- 1. Half of the amount shall be paid after the proposal defense, the remaining balance shall be given upon submission of the bound copy of approved thesis/dissertation with the Final Defense Panel Report.
- 2. The grantee should submit the manuscript to a <u>reputable</u>, <u>peer-reviewed journal</u>, such as the Philippine Journal of Psychology or other journals.
